

Eastern Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*)

A lovely native small tree that blooms vibrant lavender-pink in the early spring, before its leaves have come out. Prefers moist soils but will tolerate drier sites.

SUN - Full sun or part sun

SIZE - 20-30ft tall and 25-35ft wide

STREET TREE - No



Flowering Dogwood (*Cornus florida*)

A wonderful native small tree. Great for the edge of the woods or near the house. Single white or pink blooms cover this tree in the spring and the foliage turns red-purple in the fall. .

SUN - Sun or Part Shade

SIZE - 20-25ft tall and 15-20ft wide

Siberian Crabapple (*Malus baccata*)

A vigorous deciduous tree with rounded canopy and spreading branches ultimately reaching 20-50' high and wide. It is extremely cold-hardy. The very early fragrant pink buds open to white flowers and eventually produce yellow to bright red fruit. The fruit is a favorite food of the ruffed grouse, pheasant, woodpecker and Countless other birds rely upon the fruit, seed, buds, nectar, and flowers for food.

SUN - Full sun

SIZE - 25' to 50' tall and wide

Sargent Crabapple (*Malus sargentii*)

The Sargent crabapple is a dense, spreading, horizontally-branched, deciduous, multi-stemmed shrub. It typically grows 6-8' tall with no central leader and spreads to 15' wide. Pink buds open to a profuse, but brief, spring bloom of fragrant, white flowers (1" diameter). Profuse bloom often occurs only in alternate years. The bright red fruit is favored by cedar waxwings, robins, grosbeaks, and mockingbirds. The dark green foliage turns yellow in the fall and contrasts nicely with the red fruit. The tree's dense foliage has the added value of providing protective shelter. An excellent choice for the shrub border, in mass or near patios.

SUN - Full sun

SIZE - 6-8'tall and 15' wide

Red Maple *Acer rubrum*

One of the most popular native trees, red maples are coveted for their brilliant fall color, ability to withstand challenging soil conditions and their seeds which fall “helicopter-like” to the ground. Emerging new growth leaves, leafstalks, twigs, flowers, fruit and fall color are red or tinged with red.

SUN Full Sun

SIZE 40-70’ tall and 30-50’ wide

STREET TREE Yes



Swamp White Oak *Quercus bicolor*

A favorite choice of professional arborists, the swamp white oak is a grand shade tree with distinct leaves that are a dark green color above while being silvery-white below. As its name suggests, it thrives in wet soil situations, but can also withstand drought. Mature trees are magnificent, and a superb choice for large areas - featured in the 9/11 memorial landscape planting. Excellent wildlife attributes.

SUN Full Sun

SIZE moderate growth rate, 50- 60' high and wide

STREET TREE Superb. Allow plenty of room



American Sweetgum *Liquidamber styraciflua*

Native to the southeastern US, valued for its size, form, and fall color. Reserve for a large space where spiny-ball fruit is not an issue and there is space for root development. Provides food for wildlife.

SUN Full sun

SIZE 60-80' tall 40-60' wide

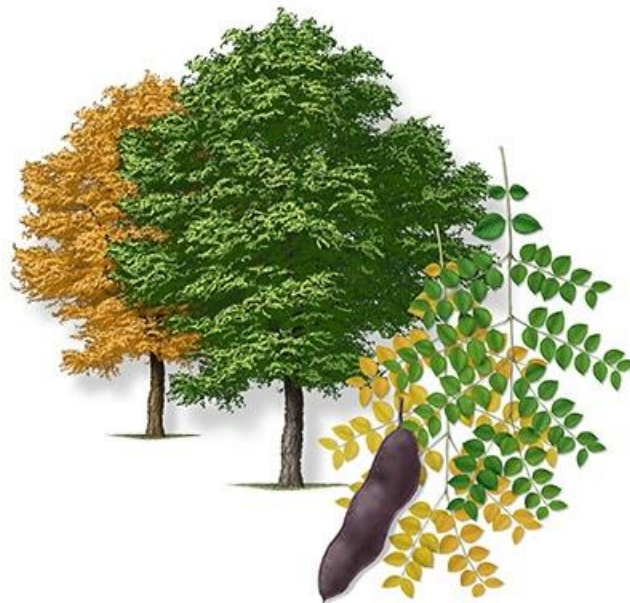
Kentucky Coffee Tree *Gymnocladus dioica*

The Kentucky coffeetree got its name from Native Americans and early American settlers who used its seeds for a coffee-like drink. It is an extremely tough shade tree with attractive, large, bluish-green leaves and greenish-white flowers that bloom in spring. This native develops into a lovely and magnificent shade tree.

SUN Full Sun

SUN 60-80' tall and 40-55' wide

STREET TREE Excellent choice



Pin Oak (*Quercus palustris*)

Pyramidal through early maturity, it's form turns more oval in older age. Fast-growing (up to 24" per year), tolerates wet soils. Glossy dark green leaves turn russet, bronze or red.

SUN Full Sun

SIZE 60-70'tall and 25-45'wide

American Linden, Basswood (*Tilia americana*)

The American linden, also known as “basswood,” is a stately shade tree with delicate pea-shaped fruits hanging from wing-shaped bracts. It is a summer-blooming tree with small white flowers, and bold, heart-shaped leaves that turn golden yellow in autumn.

SUN Full sun to part shade

SIZE 50-80' tall and 30-50' wide
